## AIMS

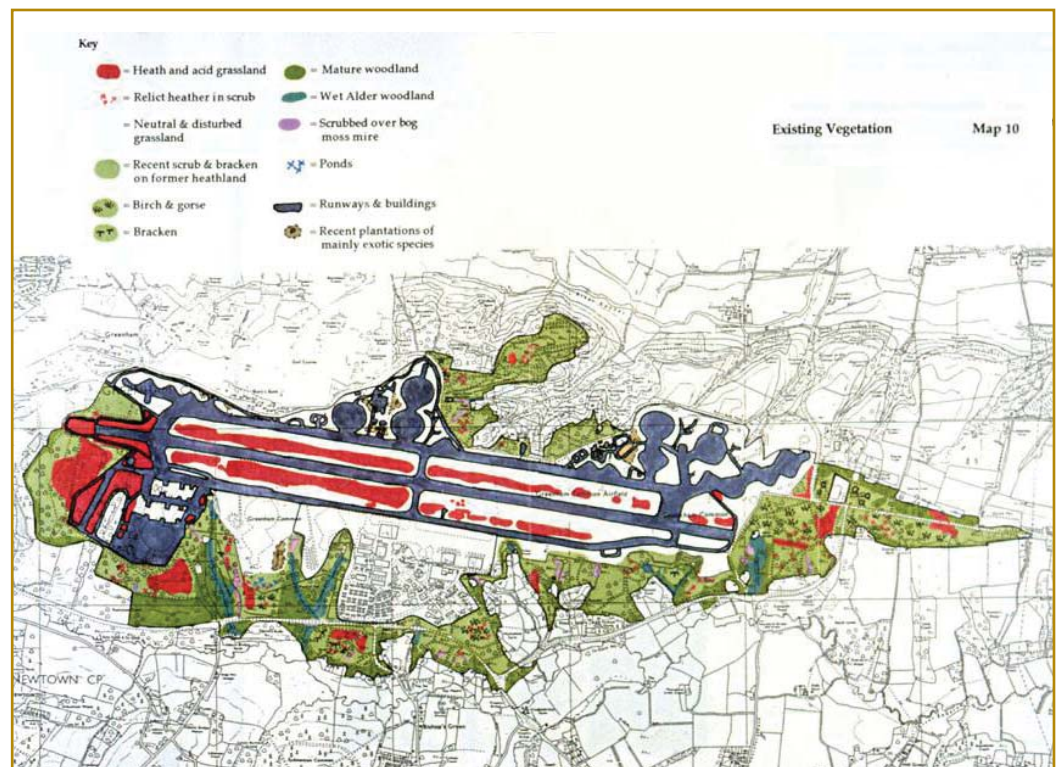
Your group are representing one of several contractors that would like to take on the job of removing the buildings and runways that are on Greenham Common. These all have to be removed before the area can be turned back into natural heathland for everyone to enjoy.

It is a lot of work and will take many years to complete. There are 235 acres of hard areas to be removed (that's more than 118 football pitches!) There is over 2 miles of runway!

The winning group will show that, not only can they predict the materials to be removed, but also they will have some good ideas about how the materials can be re-used and recycled. As little as possible must be sent to landfill, so recycling here is a very important feature!

## WHAT TO DO

This map shows the scale of the job. The areas in blue are those that need removing. Working with your group, discuss what materials you think will be in each of the areas. Then think how these might be recycled or re-used. Complete the table with your group ready to submit it to the project leader (your teacher!) They will choose who gets the job. Good Luck!
